It is the shortest Epistle addressed to any church, except the doubtful Second Thessalonians. As to matter, it is partly doctrinal and partly practical, but the doctrinal and the practical portions are not kept separate. The Epistle to the Colossians is of doubtful authorship. If it is Pauls, it was probably written at Rome, in the year 62 A. D. The principal reasons for doubting Pauls connection with it are three: (1) The similarity which exists between this Epistle and that to the Ephesians, causing many scholars to believe that one is derived from the other; (2) the fact that it contains sentiments which savor of heresies (as Gnosticism and Montanism) which did not arise until after Pauls death; (3) peculiarities of style and use of unusual words not found in Pauls undoubted writings. 1 1 Introduction to the New Testament, vol. ii. , p. 225,...
