Samuel of Exeter, and nephew of Joseph Dudley, who was governor of Massa chusetts from 1702 to 1715, under the Second Charter, and father of Chief Justice Paul Dudley. Rev. Samuel, of Exeter, was the eldest son of Thomas, second governor of Massachusetts, who was b. in England in 1576, d. at Roxbury, 1653, and was governor of Massachusetts five years, and deputy governor thirteen. Among the descendants of Governor Thomas Dudley have been men noted for their ability, and the family is connected by marriage with many of the most illustrious in New England, including Winthrop, Tyng, Woodbridge, Dummer, Dennison, Bradstreet, Leverett, and Gilman. Mrs. Clarkes mother is descended from Valentine Prentiss, who came to America in 1633. NINTH GENERATION....
