Naphthaline, protoiodide of mercury, hamamelis, or belladonna ointment freely applied to the nostrils are claimed to be beneficial; favorable results have been credited to the use of hydriodic acid syrup; a pill of atropia sulphate containing the two-hundredth of a grain given every three or four hours, until its physiological effect is produced (manifested by dryness in the throat and nose), will lessen an attack.
